This passion has driven me to pursue a career in nursing so I can help the sick and vulnerable in my community. My grandmother is failing in health and I wish I can help her get well in the near future.

Unfortunately, I am facing financial constraints that pose a significant obstacle in achieving my dream of becoming a nurse.
